

King's Dance Academy Health and Safety Policy

King's Dance Academy in conjunction is committed to the Health and Safety for everyone involved in the school.

King's Dance Academy is responsible for the buildings maintenance, maintenance of safety appliances such as fire extinguishers, electrical safety, maintenance of toilet and kitchen areas, maintenance of heating systems and general cleaning of the facilities.

While the above responsibilities for risk assessments lie with King's Dance Academy anyone who has concerns about the safety of the building, or is aware of risk is to report it to King's Dance Academy Principal.

King's Dance Academy electrical equipment will undergo Portable Appliance Testing (PAT) to conform to its responsibility for electrical safety under the Electricity at Work Regulations 1989 (EAWR).

Fire procedures are prominently displayed within the building and all teachers are aware of what action to take in the event of a fire.

In the case of an accident causing injury, first aid boxes with basic supplies are available, for more serious injuries, dependant on the extent of injury, professional medical assistance will be requested either by calling the emergency services or by escorting the injured individual to a place where they can receive treatment. In all cases parents will be informed, in the case of minor injuries at the end of class, when professional medical assistance is required they will be informed immediately.

All accidents will be recorded and logged using the form from Annex c.

King's Dance Academy will only allow performances to take place where Risk Assessments have been carried out on the venues and the facilities are deemed suitable to engage in performance.

King's Dance Academy will only use qualified personnel and engage in safe practice.
